

**PESTA SUKAN 2022**  
**COMPETITION RULES & REGULATION – SWIMMING (V9)**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1 Guided by the Rules and Regulations as directed by the Singapore Swimming Association (SSA) and in accordance with the Rules and By-laws of Fédération Internationale de Natation (FINA) and World Para Swimming (WPS) Swimming Rules and Regulations, where applicable.
- 1.2 Governed by General Rules and Regulations.
- 1.3 Performance times achieved in the Competition can be used as Qualifying Entry Times for SSA Long Course Competitions in 2022 + 2023 e.g. SNAG 2023 & SNSC (LC) 2023.
- 1.4 Swimmers who are born in 2009 or earlier must be fully vaccinated to participate at the Pesta Sukan 2022 based on VDS measures.

Individuals aged 12 years and above are considered “fully vaccinated” for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. They should receive their booster dose beyond the 270 days to maintain their vaccinated status.

Individuals who are medically ineligible for COVID-19 vaccination and unvaccinated children aged 12 and below are exempted from VDS and can participate VDS activities like fully vaccinated individuals.

**2. Pesta Sukan 2022 Age Categories & Eligibility**

- 2.1 Age is computed as of 31-Dec-2022

- 2.2 The Swim Teams can be from:
  - 2.2.1 Community Sports Clubs
  - 2.2.2 Swimming Clubs affiliated to SSA
  - 2.2.3 Primary or Secondary School Swim Teams
  - 2.2.4 Swimming Teams from ITE, Polytechnics and Universities
  - 2.3.5 Swimming Schools run by swimming instructors
  - 2.3.6 Group of swimmers forming their own Swim Teams
- 2.3 Singapore Citizen, Permanent Residents and Foreigners residing in Singapore are eligible to participate.

### 3 Pesta Sukan 2022 Age Categories & Eligibility

3.1.1 Participants from SSA Affiliates must register with their swim club / school (SSA Affiliates) using Hy-tek Team Manager Software. Submission of Hytek Team Manager Entries to [admin5@swimming.org.sg](mailto:admin5@swimming.org.sg) by **Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

3.1.2 All Participants are required to make the payment for the entry fee individually at the links below **by 24 July 2022**. Registration with ActiveSG membership is mandatory to complete the payment transaction

3.1.4 Each Affiliate / School is allowed to enter **more than one relay team** (4x50m free & 4x50m Medley) based on the age groups indicated in 3.1.5 and submission of relay entries to SSA via Hytek Software/

3.1.6 Swimmers may “swim up” in older age group categories for relay events (for all youth + adult categories)

3.1.7 For Adult 18 Yrs to 29 Yrs relay categories, swimmer above 29 years old may “swim down” to compete in the adult category if the total age of relay team members do not add up to 120 years (minimum age of masters relays)

## 5. Competition Format

5.1 The Pesta Sukan Swimming will be run in a timed finals format in 10 Lanes Pool setup from fastest to slowest

5.2 Competitors (regardless of age) shall be placed in graduated time order, fastest to slowest in 10-lane pool based on the following age groups:

## 6. An Inclusive Pesta Sukan 2022

6.1.1 Pesta Sukan 2022 Swimming Competition will include Para Swimmers participation in:  
Pesta Sukan 2022 Events (50 and 100m for all 4 strokes)

6.1.2 Para Swimmers will follow WPS Sports Classes:

- S1 – S10 = Physical Impairments
- S11 – S13 = Visual Impairments
- S14 = Intellectual Impairments
- S15 = Hearing Impairments
- S18 = Significant Other Impairment
- S19 = High Functioning Autism

6.2 Para Swimmers will have their own ranking results and medals based on Multi-Class Point System. The Australian Point System will be used.

6.3 Para Swimmers will swim in their special Para Events

## 7. Entries & Fees

7.1 The closing date **Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

7.2 Entry Fees for Individual Events:

- Youth: \$15.00 per swimmer
- Adults & Masters: \$20.00 per swimmer
- Para Swimmers: \$10.00 per swimmer
- Participants are allowed to take part up to Maximum of Five (5) Individual Events in his/her Age Category

7.3 Relay Entries:

- Each club / team / SSA affiliate are only allowed to submit 1 relay team in the respective relay categories (3.1.5) using Hy-tek Team Manager Software. Submission of Hytek Team Manager Entries to [admin5@swimming.org.sg](mailto:admin5@swimming.org.sg)
- Members of public (registered swimmers with individual events in Pesta Sukan) can form up their own relay teams and email in the details of the 4 relay swimmers to [admin5@swimming.org.sg](mailto:admin5@swimming.org.sg)
- Only registered swimmers with individual events in Pesta Sukan are allowed to compete in the relay events
- There will be no additional Entry Fee for Relay Events if the above conditions are fulfilled.

## 8 Viability of Events

8.1 Individual Events:

8.1.1 For an event to be viable there must be a minimum of **4 Registered Swimmers**. However, if there are only 3 or 2 Registered Swimmers, the event will proceed with a minus one rule for the award of medals.

## 9. Awarding of Medals

9.1 If there is a tie in any of the top 3 positions, the medals will be awarded, in accordance with FINA General Rule GR 9.7.2.1 and GR 9.7.2.2 as follows:

9.1.1 In the case of two (2) equal times:

- For 1<sup>st</sup> position: 2 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
- For 2<sup>nd</sup> position: 1 Gold, 2 Silvers, no Bronze
- For 3<sup>rd</sup> position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 2 Bronzes

9.1.2 In the case of three (3) equal times:

- For 1<sup>st</sup> position: 3 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
- For 2<sup>nd</sup> position: 1 Gold, 3 Silvers, no Bronze
- For 3<sup>rd</sup> position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 3 Bronzes

## 10. DNS and Withdrawals for Pesta Sukan Swimming 2022

10.1 During competition, any swimmer who fails to report for the event will be considered as Did Not Show (DNS). A swimmer, having entered the venue, is also considered as DNS if he/she fails to be at the Starting Block.

## 11. Swimwear

11.1 The Championship will be conducted in accordance to FINA's Rules:

BL 8.2: In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces. No additional items, like arm bands or leg bands shall be regarded as part of a swimsuit.


BL 8.3: From January 1, 2010 swimwear for men shall not extend above the navel nor below the knee, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials.

## 12. Disqualification

12.1 The Competition will use the One Start Rule. Any swimmer who starts before the starting signal shall be disqualified. If the race has started before the disqualification is declared, the race shall continue, and the swimmer(s) shall be disqualified upon completion of the race.

### 13. Protest

13.1 Protests are possible:

- a. if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed,
- b. if other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or
- c. against decisions of the referee; however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.

13.2 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee.

13.3 If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged before the signal to start the race is given.

13.4 Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:

- a. In writing, with the supporting facts
- b. With a deposit of **S\$100.00** enclosed
- c. Submitted to the Meet Referee by Affiliate Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained
- d. Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the respective event

13.5 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his decision. The Team Leader may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.

13.6 If the protest is not upheld, the deposit shall be forfeited

13.7 The Organiser's decision to any protest shall be final.

### 14 Rules & Regulations

14.1 The Rules and Regulations as depicted above are current at the time of printing or posting on Pesta Sukan 2022 website. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete and/or vary the said rules and regulations at any time as it deems fit.

14.2 Any amendments to the Rules & Regulations will be posted on Pesta Sukan 2022 website.

14.3 Any registered team that does something that causes a disqualification of the entire team during the Competition shall be fined SGD 200.00

**15. Team Leaders Meeting / Briefing**

15.1 Team Leaders Meeting / Briefing will be conducted online via Zoom on 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 11.00am. Zoom meeting link will be provided on a later date.

15.2 Swim Coaches who wish to apply for an accreditation pass to be on deck during Pesta Sukan must be an NROC Member.

Clubs / Schools are required to send in the names of their coaches and team managers (min age of 18 years old based on DOB) with their entry files to secure a pass.

**16. Others (for Members of SSA Affiliates)**

For participants who registered for the Pesta Sukan Competition as the members of SSA Affiliates, the performance times achieved at the Pesta Sukan can be used for consideration to qualify for future local / national meets and will be uploaded onto the SSA sanctioned database for ranking purposes. These participants must also pay the 2022 SSA Annual Swimmer Registration Fee via the SSA Affiliate by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022.

*Participants who competed at Pesta Sukan as unattached (or not as a member of any SSA affiliates) will not have their results uploaded onto the SSA sanctioned database.*
