- Venue: Our Tampines Hub
- Pool: Water Polo Pool
- Date: 23, 24, 30, 31 July 2022
- Time: 9am 7pm (depending on number of teams)

1. Age Group Categories as of 2022

Dates of birth shall be as at 31st Dec 2022:

- 1.1.1 10 & under (10U) Born in the year 2012 & after
- 1.1.2 12 & under (12U) Born in the year 2010 & after
- 1.1.3 18 & under (18U) Born in the year 2004 & after
- 1.1.4 Women's Open– Must be between 14 and 50 years of age (Ages below or above will be subjected to screening and approval by SWP toenter this category)
- 1.1.5 Men's Masters Starts from 35 years of age. (Ages below or above will be subjected to screening and approval by SWP to enter this category)
- 1.2 Players can choose to compete in one age group category higher if applicable

2. Competition Rules

2.1 The Tournament shall be conducted according to FINA Water Polo Rules 2019-2021 unless otherwise stated in this competition document.

3. Competition format

- 3.1 Teams will be split into 2 groups if there are 6 or more teams in a category.
- 3.2 Points awarded:
 - 3.2.1 Penalty shoot-out (PSO) for match ties
 - 3.2.2 3 points for match won
 - 3.2.3 2 points for match won by penalty shoot-out
 - 3.2.4 1 point for match draw
 - 3.2.5 0 points for match lost or forfeited
- 3.3 Depending on the number of teams, format may change





4. Playing time

- 4.1 Preliminaries (league)
 - 4.1.1 2 halves, 2 minutes interval in between
 - 4.1.2 8 minutes per half actual play time
- 4.2 Playoff (knockout)
 - 4.2.1 4 quarters, 2 minutes interval in between
 - 4.2.2 6 minutes per quarter actual play time
 - 4.2.3 Playoffs are limited to the top few teams from each category
- 4.3 Depending on the number of teams, playing time may change

5. Team size and composition

- 5.1 Each team shall have a min. of 8 players and max. 13 players
- 5.2 10U 11 players & 2 goalkeepers per game; can have mix gender
- 5.3 12U 11 players & 2 goalkeepers per game; can have mix gender
- 5.4 18U 11 players & 2 goalkeepers per game
- 5.5 Women's Open 11 players & 2 goalkeepers
- 5.6 Men's Masters 11 players & 2 goalkeepers
- 5.7 Each player may only represent one team per category
- 5.8 At least 70% ratio of Singaporean (PR inclusive) versus Foreigners in the overall team composition
- 5.9 National / carded players can take part, no limit per team.
- 5.10 Depending on the number of teams, team size and composition may change

6. Pool size

- 6.1 10U 20m by 15m
- 6.2 12U 20m by 15m
- 6.3 18U 25m by 20m
- 6.4 Women's Open 25m by 20m
- 6.5 Men's Master 25m by 20m

7. Ball Size

- 7.1 10U size 3
- 7.2 12U size 3
- 7.3 18U size 4
- 7.4 Women's Open size 4
- 7.5 Men's Master size 5





8. Size of goal post

- 8.1 10U & 12U 2m by 0.7m
- 8.2 18U onwards 3m by 0.9m

9. Entries

- 9.1 There is no limit to the number of teams each organization may enter, however priority will be given to those with only 1 team.
- 9.2 The entry fees as follows:
 - 9.2.1 10U \$80
 - 9.2.2 12U \$80
 - 9.2.3 18U \$80
 - 9.2.4 Women's Open \$120
 - 9.2.5 Men's Master \$120

10. Registration, team draw and fixture

10.1 Registration closes on Friday, 8 July 2022

Participants must register with their club / school for submission to Competition Manager; <u>tingting.koh@swimming.org.sg</u> <u>mailto:admin5@swimming.org.sg</u> by the stipulated deadline above.

The representative of the teams (participant, team manager or coach) are required to register all team members and make the payment for the team entry fee at the link below **by 10 July 2022**. Registration with ActiveSG membership is mandatory to complete the payment transaction.

11 Others

11.1 Participants who are born in 2009 or earlier must be fully vaccinated to participate at the Pesta Sukan 2022 based on VDS measures.

Individuals aged 12 years and above are considered "fully vaccinated" for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. They should receive their booster dose beyond the 270 days to maintain their vaccinated status.

Individuals who are medically ineligible for COVID-19 vaccination and unvaccinated children aged 12 and below are exempted from VDS and can participate VDS activities similar to fully vaccinated individuals.

11.2 Coaches who wish to apply for an accreditation pass to be on deck during Pesta Sukan must be an NROC Member. Clubs / Schools are required to send in the names of their coaches and team managers (min age of 18 years old based on DOB) with their entry files to secure a pass

12 Protest

- 12.0 Protest form must be submitted to the referees by Team Manager no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match.The situation and reason should be described with the FINA Rule clearly and a deposit of SGD \$500 to Competition Manager on duty.
- 12.1 If the protest is not upheld, the deposit shall be forfeited
- 12.2 The Organiser's decision to any protest shall be final.
