GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Background

GetActive! Singapore (GASG) is a national movement to celebrate National Day through sport. GASG will ensure that everyone, regardless of age and abilities, have opportunities to enjoy sport in celebration of National Day.

One of the key pillars under GASG is Pesta Sukan, the largest multi-sports competition in Singapore. Pesta Sukan aims to provide opportunity for sportsmen and women to get together in camaraderie to raise the standard of sports through friendly competition while celebrating our Nation's birthday.

2. Period

2.1 Pesta Sukan 2023 will be held from 29 Jul 2023 to 8 Aug 2023 unless otherwise approved by the Organising Committee.

2.2 The Organisers at their discretion, reserve the right to change the period of Pesta Sukan 2023.

3. Sports Competition

3.1 The series of competition shall be competed under Pesta Sukan 2023:

3.2 The participants of Pesta Sukan 2023 shall be responsible to provide accurate information during registration as required. The Organiser may check on eligibility and accuracy of entries. Player/s found ineligible or have provided inaccurate information may result in disqualification.

3.3 Pesta Sukan 2023 will consist of 32 Sports Competition, 11 Para Competition and a Singapore Challenge which comprises of 4 Signature Events and 1 GameOn NILA campaign.

3.4 Categories

3.4.1 Pesta Sukan 2023 will be featuring the following categories, unless otherwise stated by specific sports. Age limitation for each category to be decided by respective Sports.

- Open
- Masters
- Youth
- Corporate
- Community
- International
- Para

3.4.2 With effect from 2023, **Community Category** will be added to the below 4 sports

- Badminton
- Basketball
- Football
- Table Tennis

and 3 signature events

- RIBA
- SG Urban Walk Challenge
- Stadium Run

3.5 Format of Play

3.5.1 All sports competition will be conducted in the following methods.

- Group stage round robin OR Time trial, whichever applicable, in Preliminary Round
- Knock-out in subsequent rounds

3.5.2 Community Category

Team Sports (Basketball & Football)	Individual Sports (Badminton & Table Tennis)
Community Category will take priority over Men's Open Category.	Community Category will adopt a Team Format.
The tournament for Community Category shall be conducted in accordance with FIBA/FIFA rules.	Each Match will have 5 ties, comprising of 3 doubles and 2 singles.
Men's Open Category for these sports shall take on the modified format.	No repeat of player in the team line-up for each Match.
Eg. 3X3 Basketball or Futsal 5-a-side	

4. Eligibility

4.1 All age categorisation will be calculated based on Year of Birth.

Example:

Event	Age Range	Clarification
U10 Boys & Girls	8 to 10 yrs old	Born on year between 2013 and 2015
Men's Masters, 40 & above	40 yrs old and above	Born on year 1983 or earlier

4.2 All participants shall be Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents and non-Singapore Citizens residing in Singapore with valid passes as stated below:

- Student Pass;
- Long Term Pass;
- Dependent's Pass;
- Work Permit;
- S Pass; or
- Employment Pass

4.3 Participants who are aged 18 and below, i.e. born in or after 2007, must obtain parental/legal guardian consent for their participation in the tournament. Consent forms can be downloaded from Pesta Sukan 2023 official website as follows:

5. Team Composition

5.1 Team Sports

For all Team categories, each team must comprise of at least 70% Singapore citizens or permanent residents unless otherwise stated by the individual sports.

Team line-up list for every game shall consist minimum 70% Singapore citizens or permanent residents.

5.2 Corporate Category

For Corporate Team categories, at least 70% of the team must consist of full time and/or contract staff of all private, public, and non-profit organizations. In addition, at least 50% of the full time and/or staff must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents.

5.3 Community Category

5.3.1 For Community Team categories, at least 70% of the team must reside in the same Town Council and must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents.

There is no restriction on the Constituency that a player represents, as long as they reside in the affiliated Town Council.

- 5.3.2 Verification of residency to be done before the start of every game.
- 5.3.3 Current carded athletes under SSI database are only allowed to represent the Town Council they reside in. There is no limit to the number of carded athletes for each team.
- 5.3.4 Team line-up list for every game shall consist minimum 70% Singapore citizens or permanent residents residing in the same Town Council.

- 5.4 A participant can only represent 1 team in each eligible category. If a participant is found to be registered with more than one team in the same category for a particular sport after the registration closing date, the participant will be disqualified from Pesta Sukan 2023. No substitution or replacement will be allowed.

6. Registration

- 6.1 Participants may register through ActiveSG app, the official website as shown above or at any ActiveSG Sports Centre guest office.
- 6.2 For team events, Team Manager/Captain may register on behalf of the team.
- 6.3 Team Managers/Captain shall be the point of contact of the team and shall receive email confirmation of participation after payment is made.
- 6.4 Late entries will not be entertained. Incomplete submissions at the commencement of team managers' meeting shall be rejected.

7. Registration Fees

- 7.1 The closing date of registration for each sport may differ. Please check the individual sport's rules and regulations.
- 7.2 Registration Fees are as follows:

Swimming & Athletics Relays events are free of charge for individual event participants. If none of the participants are taking part in individual events, a fee of \$15 will be charged to the team.

7.3 Registration fees for individual and team events shall be made during the registration process.

7.4 Fee for team events must be made before the Team Managers meeting.

8. Payment Mode

8.1 Participants may register online or at any ActiveSG Sports Centers.

8.2 ActiveSG credits **cannot** be used for registration.

9. Prize Money and Medals

9.1 Prize Monies will **only** be applicable to Open, Masters, Corporate, Community & Para categories.

- A **minimum of 8 registered teams** is required for any event to be eligible for prize monies.

There shall be **no prize monies** for **Youth & International** categories.

- 9.2 Prize Monies for Pesta Sukan 2023 will be transferred to Winners of Individual events or Team Manager for Team events via PayNow NRIC/FIN only.
- 9.3 To access PayNow, participants can use the participating bank's existing internet banking platform or mobile banking app.
- 9.4 To receive money via PayNow into their bank account, participants need to register for PayNow service using their Singapore NRIC/FIN (One-Time Registration).
- 9.5 In the event where the Prize Winner (Individual/Team) authorize an alternate payee to receive the prize money on his/her/team behalf, upon providing the alternate payee's details, the Prize Winner has confirmed that upon payment by Sport Singapore to the alternate payee, Sport Singapore shall be discharged of all obligations and liabilities to the Prize Winner for payment of the prize money.
- 9.6 In the event where Prize monies are not claimed by **30 Sept 2023**, Sport Singapore reserves the right to forfeit the prize monies.
- 9.7 Prize Money and medals will be awarded to the top 3 winners of each event with at least 8 participants/teams.
- 9.8 For Team events, winning team will receive a trophy.
- 9.9 Only medals will be awarded when a category/event has less than 8 participants/team.
- 9.10 **Minimum of 4 participants/teams** is required for the **event to proceed**. If there are only 3 participants/teams for the event, 'minus 1 rule' applies, i.e. only 1st & 2nd will be awarded with medal.
- 9.11 If there are less than 4 participants/teams, participants may choose 1 of the following options:
- **Option 1** - Participants may withdraw and receive a full refund.
 - **Option 2** - Participants may continue with the competition but will not be eligible for prize money. Medals will be awarded based on the 'minus 1 rule'.
 - **Option 3** - Participants may opt to join another category which they are eligible for.

10. Protests

- 10.1 In the event of any dispute arising over any participant(s) and/or any team(s), the particular fixture shall be competed under protest, and the Organizer shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest in writing, together with the prescribed protest fees of \$50 for individual events and \$100 for team events.

- 10.2 Protests must be made in writing together with the protest fee and lodged with the Organizer on the spot during the match. In the event of the protest being dismissed, the fee will be forfeited.
- 10.3 The decision arising from any protest shall be final and there shall be no appeal.

11. First Aid and Medical

- 11.1 Participants with medical history are encouraged to seek medical advice before competing in this tournament.
- 11.2 First aid services are available at every venue while ambulances are deployed based on the nature and risk of the sport.
- 11.3 All teams and participants shall be responsible to ensure their own medical coverage, including first aid and personal accident insurance.

12. Supplementary Rules

- 12.1 All participations must provide a valid proof of identification on competition days as part of the verification process. This includes but is not limited to a picture ID (NRIC, Passport, driver's license, student pass, and birth certificate). Corporate participants are also required to bring their company staff pass or a letter from their company verifying that they are a staff of the company.
- 12.2 All teams are urged to participate in the spirit of fair play and sportsmanship.
- 12.3 While all reasonable precautions will be taken, Sport Singapore, their servants and agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this games.
- 12.4 All participants should refer to the rules and regulations of the individual sports for more detail on each sport.

13. Games Jurisdictions

- 13.1 The team manager and coaches are responsible for the proper control and good conduct of their participants and supporters. If an appeal is made to any of the above persons and it is not heeded, the Organiser reserves the right to take disciplinary action against the team.
- 13.2 In the event of a need for disciplinary action to be taken against any participant or team, the Organising Committee shall decide and impose punishment as it deems fit.

- 13.3 The Organiser may at any time deal with any matters pertaining to inquiries, appeals, others etc. The decision of the Organiser on all matters brought before it will be final.
- 13.4 The Organiser reserve the right to interpret said rules and regulations as they deem fit. In the event of any question or matter arising out of any point which has not been expressly provided for in any of the rules governing this competition, the decision of the Organiser will be final.
- 13.5 The rules and regulations as depicted above are current at the time of printing. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete and/or vary the said rules and regulations at any time as it deems fit.
