COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS
TABLE TENNIS

1 General Rules

- 1.1 According to the latest Rules and Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and as directed by the Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA).
- 1.2 The **Youth categories** are sanctioned by STTA with national ranking points accorded to **Singapore Citizens** only. Competition classification for ranking points shall be T3 – 19 & Under, T4 – 15 & Under, T5 – 12 & Under and T6 – 9 & Under. Please refer to STTA National Ranking Policy for details.
- 1.3 Governed by the Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2023 – General Rules and Regulations.

2.3 Team Eligibility

2.3.1 Open Team

2.3.1.1 Each team must consist of at least 4 players and maximum of 6 players and is mandatory to field a minimum of one female player per team.

2.3.1.2 Minimum of 70% of the registered players must be Singapore Citizen (SC) and/or Permanent Resident (PR) and maximum 30% of the registered players can be non-SC/PR. I.e. Up to only 1 player per team can be non-SC/PR.

2.3.2 Community Team

2.3.2.1 Each team must consist of at least 8 players and maximum of 11 players.

2.3.2.2 Minimum of 70% of the registered players must be Singapore Citizen (SC) and/or Permanent Resident (PR) and maximum 30% of the registered players can be non-SC/PR. I.e. Up to only 3 players per team can be non-SC/PR.

2.3.2.3 Minimum of 70% of the registered players must be from the Town Council they representing. I.e. Up to only 3 players per team can be from other Town Council.

3 **Event Venue & Schedule**

3.1 All matches will be held at Jurong East Sports Centre, Sports & Cultural Centre. The detailed schedule is as follows:

Note: The above schedule is subjected to change once the entries are finalised.

4 Competition Format

4.1 Competition will be played in 2 stages:

4.1.1 Stage 1

- Entries will be drawn and grouped into groups of 3 to 4 (depending on the final entries received) for each event.
- Matches will be played in a group round robin format; all matches to be decided by either best of 3 or best of 5 games of 11 points.
- Top 2 from each group will progress to Stage 2.

4.1.2 Stage 2

- Top 2 from each group will then be drawn into a single elimination format to determine the winners.
- All matches are to be decided by best of 5 games of 11 points

4.1.3 The group final ranking (ladder standing position) shall be determined according to ITTF guidelines.

4.2 Team Event Format

- In Stage 1, all matches must be played whereas in Stage 2, match will end when a team has won 2 out of 3 matches for Open Team and 3 out of 5 matches for Community Team.
- The awarding of points for each team match in Stage 1 is as follows:

- Win – 2 points
- Lose – 1 point
- Walkover (as a team) – 0 point
 - Penalty for walkover in any team individual matches: -1 point

4.2.1 Open Team Event

4.2.1.1 Open Team event consists of 3 matches, 2 Doubles and 1 Singles in the following match order:

S/N	Match Order
1	1 st Doubles Open
2	Singles Open
3	2 nd Doubles Open

4.2.1.2 Each team must register minimum of 4 players and maximum of 6 players. It is mandatory to register a minimum of one female player.

4.2.1.3 Maximum of one player can be repeated in 1 Singles and 1 Doubles match. It is mandatory to fill at least one female player in the 1st Doubles Open [1] or Singles Open [2] match in the Team Line Up.

4.2.1.4 All players indicated in the Team Line Up will be required to report at the start of the team match.

4.2.1.5 Each team may field up to a maximum of 1 non-SC/PR player in the Team Line Up of each team match.

4.2.2 Community Team Event

4.2.2.1 Community Team event consist of 5 matches, 2 Singles and 3 Doubles. The match order and details are as follows:

S/N	Match Order
1	Men's Doubles Open
2	Men's Singles Open
3	Master's Doubles (50 years & above)
4	Women's Singles Open
5	Mixed Doubles Open

4.2.2.2 Each team must register minimum of 8 players and maximum of 11 players.

4.2.2.3 Players are NOT allowed to repeat. All players indicated in the Team Line Up will be required to report at the start of the team match.

4.2.2.4 Each team may field up to a maximum of 3 non-SC/PR players in the Team Line Up of each team match.

5 Prize Money and Medals

- 5.1 Medals and Prize monies will be awarded to the top 3 positions of each event with at least 4 entries.
- 5.2 In the team event, the Champion team will be awarded with a trophy.
- 5.3 Only Medals will be awarded when there are less than 4 entries in the event i.e. 3 or less entries.
- 5.4 If there are only 3 entries for the event, 'minus 1 rule' applies, i.e. only 1st & 2nd positions will be awarded with medals but no prize money. The same 'minus 1 rule' applies if there are only 2 entries for the event, i.e. only the 1st position will be awarded with medal and not prize money.
- 5.5 In the event that there are less than 4 entries, participants may choose 1 of the following options:

Option 1 – Participants may withdraw and receive a full refund

Option 2 – Participants may continue with the competition but will not be eligible for prize money. Medals will be awarded based on the 'minus 1 rule'.

Option 3 – Participants may opt to join another category which they are eligible for.

6 Walkover

6.1 Team Event

6.1.1 A team shall concede a walkover under the following circumstances:

- If the official team line up is not submitted 15 minutes prior a scheduled match
- If player/s for the individual match do not report at the scheduled time

6.2 Individual Event

6.2.1 Participant(s) shall concede a walkover if they fail to be present on court when the match is called to play. There shall be no grace period.

7 Supplementary Rules

- 7.1 Players are allowed to register for a **maximum of 1 individual event.**

- 7.2 All players are requested to produce their Identity Card/Student Card for registration on the day of the competition.
- 7.3 The ITTF approved 3-Star 40+ mm **white** balls shall be used during the Tournament. No **white** apparels or clothing (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.
- 7.4 In the team event and doubles event, players are required to wear same attire as a team/pair for their matches.
- 7.5 Umpires will be provided for all matches for 9 & Under category and only from Quarter-finals onwards for all other categories. Players are required to be the scorekeeper when umpires are not provided.
- 7.6 The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held soon after the finals of the events. All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize. Failing which, the Organising Committee reserves the right not to award the medal and trophy.
- 7.7 For the youth age categories, each player is allowed to have an accompanying coach (who must have a valid NROC membership) to provide side coaching for his/her match(es). Proof of valid NROC membership must be shown to officials upon request. Players are not allowed to use mobile devices to make or take calls at all times during their match(es).
- 7.7 Registration deadline for Community Team is on 26 June 2023. For the remaining categories the registration deadline is on 3 July 2023.
- 7.8 Draws for the Community Team event shall be conducted on 13 July 2023. Draws for the remaining events shall be conducted on 20 July 2023. The draws shall be conducted by the referee team, witnessed by ActiveSG Staff and Technical team.
- 7.9 All players are required to sign an indemnity form prior to their participation in the competition. In addition, participants aged 16 years and below are required to submit a Parental Consent Form.
- 7.10 In the event of any dispute, the match shall be played under protest. The Organising Committee shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest in writing, together with a protest fee (amount as stated in the Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2023 – General Rules and Regulations), within one hour after the match. The decision of the Organising Committee shall be final and there shall be no further appeal.
- 7.11 The Organising Committee has the rights to include, amend or exclude any of the above terms and conditions without any prior notice.

- 1.2 Governed by the Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2023 - General Rules and Regulations.

2 Events, Eligibility & Registration Fees

- 2.1.1 Participants are required to strictly adhere to their classification categories and indicate their classification category during registration.

2.2 Eligibility

2.2.1 Participants who are not disabled classified (Refer to the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) Classification Code) will be required to write in to the Organising Committee with documentation of all medical reports and letters.

3 Event Venue & Schedule

3.1 All matches will be held at Jurong East Sports Centre. The schedule is as follows:

4 Competition Format

4.1 Competition will be played in 2 stages:

4.1.1 Stage 1

- Entries will be drawn and grouped into groups of 3 to 4 (depending on the final entries received) for each event.
- Matches will be played in a group round robin format; all matches to be decided by either best of 3 or best of 5 games of 11 points.
- Top 2 from each group will progress to Stage 2.

4.1.2 Stage 2

- Top 2 from each group will then be drawn into a single elimination format to determine the winners.
- All matches are to be decided by best of 5 games of 11 points

4.1.3 The group final ranking (ladder standing position) shall be determined according to ITTF guidelines.

4.2 Fixtures

4.2.1 Seeding will be based on the competition results of Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2022 organised by Sport Singapore. Participants who have not participated in the above-mentioned competitions will be un-seeded.

5 Prize Money and Medals

- 5.1 Medals and Prize monies will be awarded to the top 3 positions of each event with at least 4 entries.
- 5.2 Only Medals will be awarded when there are less than 4 entries in the event i.e. 3 or less entries.
- 5.3 If there are only 3 entries for the event, 'minus 1 rule' applies, i.e. only 1st & 2nd positions will be awarded with medals but no prize money. The same 'minus 1 rule' applies if there are only 2 entries for the event, i.e. only the 1st position will be awarded with medal and not prize money.
- 5.4 In the event that there are less than 4 entries, participants may choose 1 of the following options:

Option 1

- Participants may withdraw and receive a full refund

Option 2

- Participants may continue with the competition but will not be eligible for prize money. Medals will be awarded based on the 'minus 1 rule'.

Option 3

- Participants may opt to join another category which they are eligible for.

6 Walkover

- 6.1 Participant(s) shall concede a walkover if they fail to be present on court when the match is called to play after a grace period of ten (10) minutes.

7 Supplementary Rules

- 7.1 For wheelchair category from Class 1 to Class 5, all wheelchairs used for competition should be manual unless prior approval is given to use electric powered wheelchair. Those seeking to use electric powered wheelchair would need to provide supporting documents from medical doctors. Approval for use of electric powered wheelchair is at the discretion of the Organising Committee. Such approval can be sought by writing in to the Organising Committee.
- 7.2 All players are requested to produce their Identity Card/Student Card for registration on the day of the competition.

- 7.3 The ITTF approved 3-Star 40+ mm **white** balls shall be used during the Tournament. No **white** apparels or clothing (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.
- 7.4 The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held soon after the finals of the events. All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize. Failing which, the Organising Committee reserves the right not to award the medal and trophy.
