PESTA SUKAN COMMUNITY CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS TABLE TENNIS

1 General Rules

- 1.1 According to the latest Rules and Regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and as directed by the Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA).
- 1.2 Governed by the Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2024 General Rules and Regulations.

2 Competition Event

2.1 Event & Age Requirements

3 Event Venue & Schedule

3.1 All matches will be held at Jurong East Sports Centre, Sports & Cultural Centre with the Finals to be held at OCBC Arena. The detailed schedule is as follows:

4 Team Composition

4.1 Community Team event consists of 3 Doubles matches in the following match order:

- 4.2 Each team must register minimum of 6 players and maximum of 9 players. Players are not allowed to repeat.
- 4.3 Each team must comprise at least two-thirds Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents and residing in the GRC Clusters they are representing, i.e. each team can only register up to a maximum of 3 non-Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents and non-residents of the GRC Clusters they are representing.
- 4.4 Each player is only allowed to represent one team to participate in the event.

5 Competition Format

5.1 Competition will be played in 2 stages:

5.1.1 Stage 1: Preliminary Stage

- Entries will be drawn into groups of 3 or 4 (depending on the final entries received) for the event.
- Each group will play a round robin.
- Top 2 from each group will advance to Stage 2.
- Group final ranking shall be determined according to ITTF guidelines.

5.1.2 Stage 2: Main Draw

- Single knock-out elimination format
- Team Match will end when a team has won 2 out of 3 individual matches.
- 5.2 Matches are to be decided by best of 5 games of 11 points
- 5.3 There will be no seedings. Teams shall be drawn randomly into groups with separation of GRC clusters for the preliminary stage.

6 Prize Money and Medals

6.1 Medals and Prize monies will be awarded to the top 3 positions.

7 Walkover

7.1 Player/Pair shall concede a walkover if they fail to be present for his or her match in a team match and the Team will proceed to play the next preceding tie. There shall be no grace period.

8 Supplementary Rules

8.1 The ITTF approved 3-Star 40+ mm **white** balls shall be used during the Tournament. No **white** apparels or clothing (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.

- 8.2 Team players are required to wear attire of similar colours for their matches.
- 8.3 All Team Managers/Captains must report to officials' table **at least 30 minutes** before the scheduled match to collect their team line-up and submit the line-up form **15 minutes** before the scheduled time.
- 8.4 Team lineup will be filled automatically by the referee team in order of the team registration list if the lineup is not submitted **5 minutes** before the scheduled match time.
- 8.5 Umpires will only be provided from Quarter-finals onwards. Teams are required to get their players to be the scorekeeper when umpires are not provided.
- 8.6 The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held soon after the finals. All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize. Failing which, the Organising Committee reserves the right not to award the medal and trophy.
- 8.7 Players are not allowed to use mobile devices to make or take calls at all times during their match(es).
- 8.8 Draws for the competition shall be conducted on 28 June 2024. The draws shall be conducted by the referee team, witnessed by ActiveSG Staff and Technical team.
- 8.9 Master Schedule draws and fixtures shall be published on 1 July 2024 at Pesta Sukan website as well as STTA website. ActiveSG would not be sending notifications with regards to the schedule and fixtures. Teams are required to check their match timings on their own accord.
- 8.10 All players are required to sign an indemnity form prior to their participation in the competition. In addition, participants aged 16 years and below are required to submit a Parental Consent Form. In the event if the indemnity form is not submitted before the start of his/her first match, the player will not be allowed to play in the match.
- 8.11 In the event of any dispute, the match shall be played under protest. The Organising Committee shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest in writing, together with a protest fee (amount as stated in the Get Active! Singapore Pesta Sukan 2024 General Rules and Regulations), within one hour after the match. The decision of the Organising Committee shall be final and there shall be no further appeal.
- 8.12 The Organising Committee has the rights to include, amend or exclude any of the above terms and conditions without any prior notice.
