RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **AQUA Ekiden** ("Event") is organised by ActiveSG and World Aquatics Championships Singapore Organising Committee ("Organisers") in accordance with these Rules and Regulations ("R&R") applicable to the registered participants ("Participant(s)").
2. Details on the Event, including Event date, registration information and fees can be found on the <https://www.activesgcircle.gov.sg/getactive-singapore/pesta-sukan> ("Official Website") and <https://gameonsg60.worldaquatics-singapore2025.com/>
3. The Participant must sign up with the team registration details through the <https://www.activesgcircle.gov.sg/getactive-singapore/pesta-sukan> ("Official Website") and complete the payment by the stipulated closing date ("Closing Date"). Registration after the Closing Date, 6 July 2025 and up till the Event Day itself on 26 July 2025 will not be accepted.
4. The Event has the following categories:

Open Team (Team of 3 to 6)	16 years old & above	\$45 per team
Corporate Team (Team 3 to 6)	18 years old – 63 years old	\$45 per team

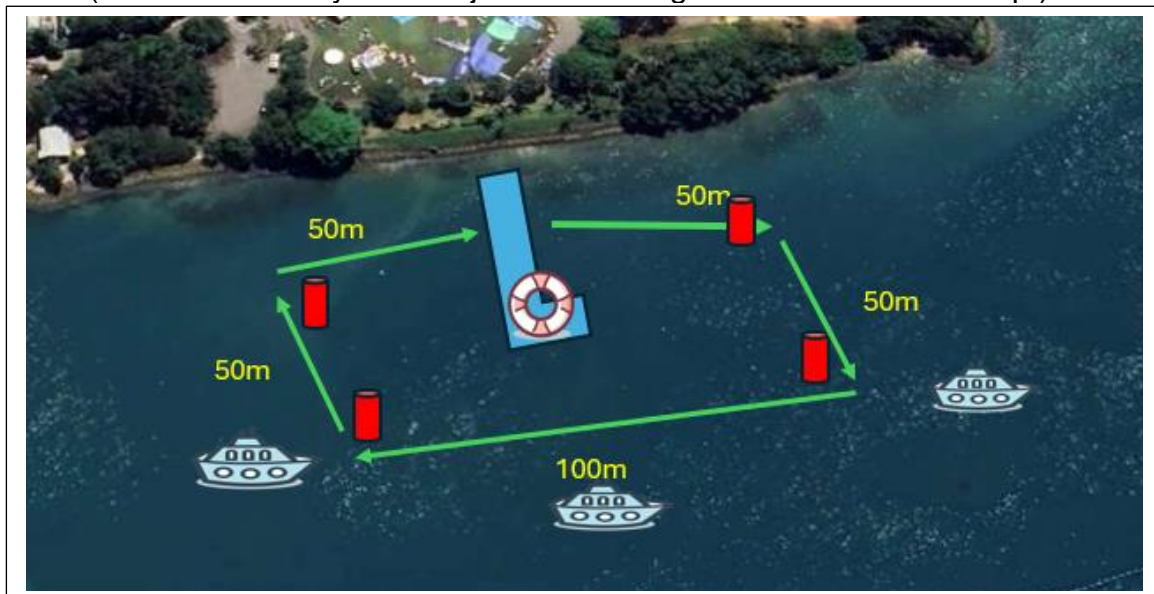
5. This is not a time-based competition, no issuance of timing system, Complete the entire open water swim route of 1.8km as a team to be entitled to finisher medal.

EVENT INFORMATION

1. Title: AQUA Ekiden
2. Date: 26 July 2025 (Saturday)
3. Venue: Sentosa Palawan Beach (World Aquatics Championships Open Water Swimming Competition Venue)
4. Format: Open Water Relay Swimming
5. Event Duration: 3:00pm to 6:00pm (by wave start)
6. Race Format:
 - a. Team of 3 to 6 swimmers (Team with less than 6 swimmers should have other swimmers to swim 2 laps to complete the 1.8km distance)
 - b. Each swimmer completes a minimum of 300m of open water swim
 - c. Total relay distance: 1.8km
 - d. Changeover to be conducted in designated transition zone

REGISTRATION

1. All Participants must register and complete payment for the Event via the "Official Website".
2. Payment mode will be via ActiveSG Plus.
3. Once the registration form and payment have been submitted, participants will receive the confirmation email within 7 working days after the Closing Date for registration.
4. Registration for the Event is only confirmed after the Organisers receive the correct payment.
5. In event that the Participant did not receive the confirmation email 7 working days after the Closing Date of submitting the registration and payment, the Participant can contact the Organisers at <https://gameonsg60.worldaquatics-singapore2025.com/contactus/>
6. The Participant agrees to: (i) provide true, accurate, current and complete information about the Participant contained in the registration form (the "Registration Data"); (ii) maintain the security of the Participant's password and identification; and (iii) maintain and promptly update the Registration Data to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. Otherwise, the Organisers may suspend or terminate the Participant's registration.
7. The Organisers reserve the right to contact and to interview the Participant for additional information required for matters relating to this Event.
8. The Organisers may contact the Participant from time to time by email and/or on mobile phones. Any notice sent to the email address or messages sent to the mobile phone registered with the Organisers shall be deemed as received by the Participant.
9. Completion of the online registration form confirms the Participant's agreement to abide by these R&R of the Event.

GENERAL

1. The Organisers reserve the right to modify or substitute any of these R&R from time to time as it deems fit. If there is ambiguity in any of these provisions, the Organisers shall be the authority to interpret and in so doing, they will take into account the interest of the affected Participant. Any amendments to these R&R will be updated on the “Official Website”.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to use any photographs (including those of the Participant), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of the Event, for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.
3. All Participants must be at the designated start point 60 minutes before the start of the Event.

ELIGIBILITY

All age categorization will be calculated based on Year of Birth.

Open Team (Team of 3-6)	16 years old and above	Born on year 2009 or earlier
Corporate Team (Team of 3-6)	18 years old to 63 years old	Born on year between 1962 and 2007

All participants shall be Singapore Citizens, Singapore Permanent Residents and non-Singapore Citizens residing in Singapore with valid passes as stated below:

- Student Pass;
- Long Term Pass;
- Dependent's Pass;
- Work Permit;
- S Pass; or
- Employment Pass

Participants who are aged 18 and below, i.e. born in or after 2007, must obtain parental/legal guardian consent for their participation in the tournament. Consent forms can be downloaded from Pesta Sukan 2025 official website as follows:

TEAM COMPOSITION

This is a mixed team event with no restriction to gender mix. For instance, it can be a full formation of 6 persons who are all males, females or a mix of genders.

Open Categories

For all Team categories, each team must comprise of at least 70% Singapore citizens or permanent residents unless otherwise stated by the individual sports.

Corporate Category

For Corporate Team categories, at least 70% of the team must consist of full time and/or contract staff of all private, public, and non-profit organizations. In addition, at least 50% of the full time and/or staff must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents.

A participant can only represent 1 team in each eligible category. If a participant is found to be registered with more than one team in the same category for a particular sport after the registration closing date, the participant will be disqualified from Pesta Sukan 2025. No substitution or replacement will be allowed.

ENTITLEMENT AND MEDALS

- Finisher Medals will be awarded to all participants who completed the open water swim route as a team.
- A corporate champion trophy will be awarded to the organisation with the most number of participants completing the AQUA Ekiden.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

1. All participants will be provided with the following and to be completed the before the start of the event:
 - Complete a mandatory safety briefing
 - Sign water safety declaration form
2. Safety vessels and lifeguards will be stationed along the course
3. Event may be postponed or cancelled based on weather and sea conditions
4. Whilst reasonable precaution will be taken by the Organisers to ensure the Participant's safety, the Participant takes part in the Event at his/her own risk and the Organisers will not be responsible or held liable for any injury or death howsoever arising from training for or participating in the Event.
5. Each Participant is responsible for his/her own safety throughout the Event and agrees to the indemnity conditions upon submission of registration.
6. The Participant is strongly encouraged to consult his/her medical practitioner prior to registration and before the actual Event.
7. The Organisers shall not be liable for any loss and/or damage, whether personal or otherwise, and howsoever arising.
8. The Participant must retire from the Event immediately if required to do so by any member of the official medical staff and/or Organisers.

RACE RULES

1. Teams must complete check-in 60 minutes before race start
2. Each swimmer must:
 - Complete their leg in sequence
 - Tag their teammate in designated transition zone
 - Follow course markers and safety instructions

3. Use of swimming aids or fins is not permitted
4. Wetsuits are optional

CANCELLATION AND AMENDMENTS

1. There will be no refund of any fees paid if the Event is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. These include but are not limited to bad weather, NEA advisory against outdoor activities, or any other advisories relating to the safety of the Participants.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel the Event at any time without prior notice to the Participant, in which case they will make reasonable effort to inform the Participant prior to the Event.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the open water swim routes as they deem fit for the safety of the Participant and/or to prevent any potential hazards at any time without prior notice to the Participant. In such cases, every effort will be made to inform the Participant prior to the day/date of the Event. The Organisers shall not be liable for any other loss or inconvenience caused due to such changes.

USE OF PERSONAL DATA

1. The Participant, who has registered to take part in the Event, is deemed to have given written permission to the Organisers to collect, analyse and collate any personal information relating to that Participant, as the Organisers may at their sole discretion deem fit, for the Organisers' programmes, planning, data-processing, statistical or risk-analysis, research, fund-raising and/or, any other purposes defined by the Organisers.
2. All the Participant data will never be sold or exchanged.
