# GETACTIVE! SINGAPORE <u>PESTA SUKAN 2025</u> <u>BADMINTON</u>

# 1. Rules

- 1.1 Tournament shall be subjected to requirements stipulated under the latest Safe Management Measures advisory issued by SportSG. Tournament may be postponed, suspended or cancelled following the guidelines of the advisory
- 1.2 According to the Laws/Rules established by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) and as directed by the Singapore Badminton Association (SBA) (www.bwfbadminton.org & www.singaporebadminton.org.sg) and,
- 1.4 General rules of GetActive Singapore and Singapore Youth Olympic Festival for Youth categories.

# 3. Event Venue & Schedule

# 4. Events & Format of play

4.1 The list of events shall be as follows:

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Note: Any event/s, with less than 8 entries may be cancelled.

#### 4.2 Team Registration & Format

A team must register the following minimum number of players:

- 4.2.1 No players can register in more than One (1) Team Event. If a participant is found to be registered with more than one team in the same category for a particular sport after the registration closing date, the participant will be disqualified from Pesta Sukan 2025. No substitution or replacement will be allowed
- 4.2.2 No replacements will be entertained after registration closes.
- 4.3 The preliminary round for all categories will be played on a round robin group stage based on 1 match of 30 points scoring system. Top players / team from each group will advance to the next round of knock out stage.
- 4.4 The knockout stage will also be played on best of 3 games on the 21 rally point system. This is subjected to the final entries.
- 4.5 Finals & 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> Playoff

The winners of Semi-Finals Round will enter the Finals Playoff to play for the Gold and Silver position of the competition. The losers of Semi-Finals Round will be awarded Bronze Medals (Joint-Third) by default.

4.7 Closing date for entries is on <u>Wed, 15 June 2025.</u>

#### 5. Walkover

Any player/pair who fails to report to the umpire at the specified court, the match will be declared a walkover after a 5-minute grace period (time start once umpire on court) and all points will be awarded to the opponent.

#### 6. Retirement

Any player/pair who decides to retire due injury will have retain their points at point of retirement and concede all remaining points of the match to their opponents. For example, should a match be retired at 5-3 (5 being the score of the retiring entry), that would mean final score 5-21 (in a single 21 point game) or 5-30 (in a single 30 point game) or 5-21, 0-21 (in a best of 3 games of 21 point if it is in the first game).

# 7. Withdrawal

Any player/pair who withdraws from competition at any point will be removed from the competition and all scores shall be deemed null and void.

#### 8. Disqualification

- 8.1 Player/s will be disqualified in the event of unruly conduct or cheating.
- 8.2 The Organiser reserve the right to disqualify player/s at its discretion and take further disciplinary action that could be in the form of a term ban in GetActive Singapore Competition Series.
- 8.3 Disqualification just prior to start of a tie will result in conceding walkover and walkover would mean conceding 0-30 (in a single 30 point game) or 0-21 points (in a single 21 point game) or 0-21, 0-21 (in a best of 3 games)

# 9. Equipment & Attire

- 9.1 The organiser shall decide the competition grade shuttlecocks to be used for this competition.
- 9.2 All players must be appropriately attired for the matches. Players shall wear non-marking shoes during the competition.
- 9.3 All double players from the same team are encouraged to be in uniformed attire for the single elimination stage onwards.

# 10. Reporting

- 10.1 Players/Teams are advised to register their attendance at least **45 minutes** prior to their scheduled match time. Scheduled matches can be called in to play up to **10 minutes** earlier if the preceding matches end well ahead of schedule.
- 10.2 For Team events, the team line up must be submitted to no later than **30 minutes** prior the scheduled match.
- 10.3 Participant(s) must bring along and produce either his/her valid Singapore pink or blue identity card or student pass with NRIC number. For corporate event, letter from company HR to validate employment of players must be produced at the registration table. Failing which, he/she will not be allowed to compete in the match.
- 10.4 Participant(s) who are non-Singapore Citizens residing in Singapore must bring along and produce a valid Student Pass or Passport. All teams are allowed to register and play 1 non staff (corporate team) of the team component. Failing which he / she will not be allowed to play.

#### 11. Registration

11.1 Participants may register through the official website, https://www.activesgcircle.gov.sg/getactive-singapore/Pesta-Sukan or at any ActiveSG Sports Centre guest office;

- 11.2 For team events, Team Manager/Captain may register on behalf of the team;
- 11.3 Team Managers/Captain shall be the point of contact of the team and shall receive email confirmation or SMS of participation after payment is made.
- 11.4 Team manager must be registered as a participant to be able to participate in any matches.
- 11.5 Late entries will not be entertained. Incomplete submissions shall be rejected.
- 11.6 Changes to participant details will not be entertained after registration close.

#### 12. Prize Money and Medals

- 12.1 Prize Monies will only be applicable to Open, Masters, Corporate, Community & Para categories.
  - A minimum of 8 registered teams is required for any event to be eligible for prize monies.
- 12.2 There shall be no prize monies for Youth categories.
- 12.3 Prize Monies for Pesta Sukan 2025 will be transferred to Winners of Individual events or Team Manager via PayNow.
- 12.4 To access PayNow, participants can use the participating bank's existing internet banking platform or mobile banking app.
- 12.5 To receive money via PayNow into their bank account, participants need to register for PayNow service using their Mobile Number and/or Singapore NRIC/FIN (One-Time Registration).
- 12.6 In the event that the Prize Winner (Individual/Team) authorise an alternate payee to receive the prize money on his/her/team behalf, upon providing the alternate payee's details, the Prize Winner has confirmed that upon payment by Sport Singapore to the alternate payee, Sport Singapore shall be discharged of all obligations and liabilities to the Prize Winner for payment of the prize money.
- 12.7 In the event where Prize monies are not claimed by 30 October 2025, Sport Singapore reserves the right to forfeit the prize monies.
- 12.8 Medals will be awarded to the top 4 winners of each event with at least 4 participants/Teams;
- 12.9 If there are only 3 participants for the event, 'minus 1 rule' applies, i.e. only 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> will be awarded with medal but no prize money;
- 12.10 If there are less than 4 participants/teams, participants may choose 1 of the following options:
  - Option 1 Participants may withdraw and receive a full refund
  - **Option 2** Participants may continue with the competition but will not be eligible for prize money. Medals will be awarded based on the 'minus 1 rule'.

• **Option 3** - Participants may opt to join another category which they are eligible for.

# 13. Competition Jurisdiction

- 13.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the competition at any time. Notifications of such changes will be posted on the Pesta Sukan 2025 official website. All participants are advised to visit the competition website frequently for any notices or changes to draws or schedules.
- 13.2 While reasonable precautions will be taken, the organisers, its servants and agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this competition.
