

<u>COMPETITION INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS</u> (Children)

1. Event organizer

This event is organized by the SportSG / Singapore Judo Federation (SJF).

SJF is moving on the right track in the long-term development of Judo Pathway plans.

Children's Judo competitions are valuable for developing skills, building confidence, and fostering sportsmanship in a safe environment, while also providing a platform for kids to experience Judo sports. Sportsmanship and Respect: Judo emphasizes respect for opponents, coaches, and the sport itself. Competitions provide opportunities for children to learn and practice these values.

2. Competition Details

3. Eligibility

Participants must meet the following criteria: Children (Boys / Girls)

- Minimum grade of 2nd MON Grade (White Two Bar Belt)
- Minimum grade of 5th KYU Garde (Yellow Belt)
- Meet age requirements (Calendar Year).

Children (MON) - U10: min age 8 and 9 years old (Born in 2017 and 2016)

Children (MON) - U12: min age 10 and 11 years old (Born in 2015 and 2014)

Children (KYU) - U14: min age 12 and 13 years old (Born in 2013 and 2012)

For Athletes below 19 years old, parental consent is compulsory

Registered with SJF or National Judo Federation (proof required).

4. Competition regulations

The competition will be contested on 2 mat areas, in accordance with the 2024 International Judo Federation (IJF) Sports Rules and Regulations.

5. Judo Uniform

White uniform is compulsory (2024 IJF specifications).



6. System of contest

The matches will be contested in the 'League system' and/or the 'knock-out' system, with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage and depending on the number of entries received.

- If there is only one (1) participant registered for the category, the organizer shall cancel the category.
- If there are two (2) athletes it will be the best of two (2) contests and if the wins are equal (1-1), a third contest will decide.

7. Contest times

Match duration for the respective divisions shall be:

Scoring system will apply. In the event of a draw, the Golden Score rule will apply, and the match will continue until one winner is declared. The Modified rules with additional safeguards and educational aspects will be add in this competition. The "Golden score" limit with 1 or 2 minutes time, will call for "Hantei" by referees.

8. Competition Rules for Children

The following competition rules will apply:

• U14 / U12 / U10 Category (Boys / Girls):

Both Shime-Waza (Chokes / Strangulations), Tomoe-Nage (Stomach Throws), Maki-Komi (Winding Throws) and Kansetsu-Waza (Arm Locks) are not allowed to execute. Judokas who applied the above techniques mentioned will be given "Hansoku make" (immediate disqualification) by the referees.

- --- Judokas (Tori) are not allowed to execute diving technique and Judokas who failed to comply will be given "Hansoku make" (immediate disqualification) by the referees.
- --- Leg grab techniques mentioned in the IJF rules 2024 are not allowed. Judokas found using the technique will be penalized with "Shido" and subsequent penalties will be enforced by the referees.



--- The use of any series "Sankaku Gatame or Jime" (Triangular neck /arm lock) is also not allowed to be executed by all Judokas. The referees will stop the bout immediately when a Judoka is found to be using this technique, however, no penalty will be issued.

--- Judo movements where Judokas (Tori) landed directly onto the mat on their knee(s) is not allowed. Judokas who execute such movements will be issued "Shido" for the first instance and repeating this move would lead to "Hansoku make" (immediate disqualification)

*NOT ALLOW- CHOCKs /ARMBARs/ DROP KNEEs/ MAKEKOMIs

10.Age limit and waiver

- Clubs / Schools must ensure participants meet the age requirements.
- Participation waiver / indemnity shall be the responsibility of the clubs / schools.
- Participants are advised to have insurance coverage (including 3rd party liability).
- SJF shall not be responsible for incidents arising from this event.

10. Registration and Payment

- No limit of number per category.
- An athlete may only be registered in (1) division / category.
- <u>Individual entries will not be accepted.</u>
- Club Representatives are to email the entry form only.
- Registration closes at 2200hrs on 6th July 2025 (Sunday).
- No refunds will be entertained due to cancellation or withdraw from club/school.
- Draw of bouts will be 18th July 2025 (Friday) 2000hrs at SJF office.
- Submitting of the relevant documents will be handled via emails, no hardcopy is needed

12. Weigh in

Weigh in will be held at the venue indicated in the schedule, current IJF regulations will apply. No allowance will be given.

- a. Girls are to be in shorts and round neck T-shirts
- b. Boys are to wear only shorts

Participants who are not present at call time will be disqualified.

*Players who are underweight or overweight will be automatically disqualified from his or her event.

14.Prizes and awards

There will be 3 or 4 medals for each individual category: 1st, 2nd and 3nd or joint 3rd will be awarded. Athletes must attend the medal ceremony with their white judo uniform.

15.Medical Coverage

Immediate first aid will be provided on site. An ambulance will be available to transport athletes requiring further attention to the nearest medical facility (treatment at own cost).
