



Cessation of New Provisional Membership

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: Who will be affected by this cessation of new Provisional Coach membership?

A: This cessation only affects individuals who are not currently a NROC member and who wish to apply to be a member. All new membership shall be as a full member. Visit [NROC \(sportsingapore.gov.sg\)](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg) to find out the requirements to be a full member.

Q: I have a Provisional Coach membership currently. Will I be affected?

A: No. Your Provisional Coach membership validity will remain until the expiration date stated on your NROC e-card. After which, you would be required to have the necessary certifications to apply for Level 1 Coach.

Q: I am not a NROC Coach and would like become a member and start a career in coaching, what are the requirements?

A: You can join as a full member of NROC. For Level 1 Coach, the pre-requisites are; a valid Standard First Aid, SG-Coach Theory Level 1, SG-Coach Technical Level 1, and Foundational Sport Science. For more information, do visit [NROC \(sportsingapore.gov.sg\)](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg)

Q: I have a Diploma/Degree in PE Teaching, will my qualifications be recognized for membership application to NROC?

A: We have a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Programme where we recognize diplomas and degrees from certain Institutes of Higher Learning. You may apply to receive direct waiver for the [SG-Coach Theory](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg) and/or [Sport Science](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg) requirements. Q: I have the National Coaching Accreditation Programme (NCAP) certificates, are those recognized for NROC membership?

A: Yes, the NCAP certificates are recognized and you can apply to be a NROC member using those certificates. Find out more at [NROC \(sportsingapore.gov.sg\)](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg)

Q: I have been coaching for a long time, can my knowledge, skills and experiences be recognized for my application to be an NROC member?

A: We have a Recognition of Prior Experience (RPE) Programme where we recognize individuals who are ≥40 years old and have ≥10 years of coaching experience. Find out more at [NROC \(sportsingapore.gov.sg\)](https://sportsingapore.gov.sg)



Q: What if there is a long wait for registration of coaching courses?

A: We work closely with the National Sports Associations (NSAs) and our training partner; Republic Polytechnic in running coaching courses. Should there be a high demand, more courses may be scheduled to meet the increased demand.

A: You may proceed to complete the [SG-Coach Theory Level 1](#) and [Foundational Sport Science](#) before your membership expiry date first and to write in to us at sport_coaching@sport.gov.sg.
