

# **INSPIRING NEW HEIGHTS**



On 13 August 2016, Joseph Schooling ended Singapore's 56-year wait for a second Olympic male medallist when he came in first place in the 100m butterfly with a Games record of 50.39 seconds. This was also Singapore's first-ever Olympic Gold medal.

It was a day to remember not only for Joseph, but also for Singaporeans as the Gold medal sent an important message to the nation and many other aspiring athletes, that no dream is impossible. In his own words, "Dream big and reach for the stars."

The following year, swimming experienced a 24% increase in participation rates and ranked fourth nationwide as the sport most regularly taken up. In addition, swimming also achieved their best away results at the 2017 SEA Games with 24 Golds, 17 Silvers and 15 Bronzes, and at the 2018 Asian Games with 2 Golds (Both won by Joseph), 1 Silver and 3 Bronzes.

According to former National Head Coach Stephan Widmer, Joseph's Olympic Gold was the catalyst for the swim team's successes because "Joseph (gave) Singaporeans the belief that (they) can compete with the best in the world. Now you can see coaches believe, swimmers believe and it's a great momentum."



#### ABOUT ONE TEAM SINGAPORE FUND

The One Team Singapore Fund (OTSF) was established in 2017 to enable all supporters of Team Singapore to contribute towards strengthening the High Performance Sport (HPS) system. It offers one-for-one matching grants, up to \$50 million, from the Government for cash donations to support Team Singapore athletes. Donations to OTSF provide national athletes with additional support to achieve, perform and compete their best at the highest level of competitions.

To continue support for our Team Singapore athletes and to strengthen the HPS system, it was announced during Budget 2022 that the OTSF Matching Grant will be extended for another five years until FY2026.

Currently, there are seven HPS areas supported by the OTSF. They are:

**1. Pathway Development**- to strengthen developmental pathways for Team Singapore athletes;

**2. Coach Development** - to raise the expertise and professionalism of coaches;

Sport Science and Sport - for the provision of SSSM support;
 Medicine (SSSM)

**4. Training Environment**to enhance the daily training environment for Team Singapore athletes locally or overseas;

5. Data Analytics, Technology - to enhance competitive edge through the use of data, technology and innovation;

**6. Management Capability** - to strengthen capabilities to develop and implement multi-year sports plan:

**7. Competition Opportunities** - to enhance competition opportunities at the Regional, Continental, World/Olympics level and their para equivalent.



# **DEFYING ALL EXPECTATIONS**



Born with muscular dystrophy, a degenerative condition that weakens muscles, Yip Pin Xiu lost her ability to walk at the tender age of 13. Instead of feeling defeated, she was determined to show that she could swim like a dolphin. Now a five-time Paralympic Gold medallist and a holder of two world records, Pin Xiu blazed a trail for para-sport in Singapore when she won Singapore's first Paralympic Gold at the 2008 Beijing Paralympics. She is also the first para-athlete to enter Singapore's Sport Hall of Fame in 2015.

Pin Xiu is living proof that one's physical limitations do not define a person. Even at the expense of her condition deteriorating, Pin Xiu was determined to make something of herself and achieve her dreams.

She said, "I want to show Singaporeans that as long as you set your mind on something, regardless of your circumstances, you can find opportunities along the way and you can reach your goal."

Also a former Nominated Member of Parliament, Pin Xiu is keen to make a difference to better Singapore's sporting scene. She said, "I hope to use my experience...to make our sporting culture a more vibrant one. I also hope to bring a fresh voice for youth and speak up for equality."



# **CHASING THE DREAM**




At the age of 18, Loh Kean Yew was so determined on chasing his dream of becoming a professional badminton player that he dropped out of tertiary studies to pursue the path less travelled.

And so he gave everything he had to hone his craft. At training, he was always looking for ways to improve his game. It is with this spirit of dedication and discipline that allowed Kean Yew to climb the men's singles rankings, before claiming the title of Singapore's first badminton World Champion in 2021. Following his historic victory, he remains a dominant force in the sport, rising to a career-high third place world ranking in November 2022 - the first time a Singaporean men's badminton player has reached the top three in the world.

Kean Yew's dream and goal always has been the Olympic Gold for Singapore. The Singapore Sports School alumnus once famously said this in a text message to encourage his juniors in the National team - "Set a goal, big enough for people to laugh at. They laugh because it's impossible for them. They're the weakling, not you. Work hard towards it."



# FOR DAD, FOR COUNTRY



In February 2016, Amita Berthier and her teammates made history by winning Singapore's first-ever women's cadet team gold at the Asian Junior and Cadet Fencing Championships in Bahrain. The victory was bittersweet for Amita as this achievement came just three weeks after her father passed away at a workplace accident.

Since then, Amita has turned the personal tragedy to fuel her successes in the sport. Every time she steps into the fencing arena, she fights for more than just glory and the pride of her country, but also for her parents, who are one of her biggest supporters. "The fact that they had so much faith and so much support for me, I owe everything to my mum and dad," she explained.

Despite her youth, 22-year-old Amita has already achieved a number of impressive and historic feats. By 2022, she had already won Singapore's first ever World Cup medal; two SEA Games individual golds; a world junior No. 1 ranking; became the first Singaporean fencer to qualify for the Olympic Games; and was named the Women's Foil Athlete of the Year in the United States.

However, the Amita has set her sights on even greater success. She is determined to continue climbing the ranks and to one day stand atop the podium at the Olympic Games.

# **NEVER STOP BELIEVING**



Nur Syahidah Alim took her first shot in archery at age 18 and instantly felt a connection. Para-archery gave her the option to play the sport while seated, thus relieving pressure from her lower body. It was perfect for Syahidah who relished the opportunity to play sports but found it a challenge due to diplegia, a type of cerebral palsy that compromises her mobility, balance and posture in the lower half of her body.

Growing up, Syahidah's mother was determined to raise her daughter to believe she could do anything she wanted, and to never let her feel she was handicapped in any way. "My mum has had this perception that I should be prepared to be independent. There wasn't any excuse that I couldn't do it. That's how I grew up and it helped me to be who I am today."

Syahidah has proven her talent in the sport over the years. In 2016, Syahidah became the first female archer to represent Singapore at the Rio Paralympic Games. Thereafter in 2019, she won Singapore's first World Archery Para Championships, and topped the Para Compound Women Open Individual rankings.

Life has not been easy for the two-time Paralympian and triple ASEAN Para Games gold medallist, but she has overcome all the odds to get to where she is today. "I believe that my past experiences and tough childhood have given me the perseverance and determination to succeed in anything I want to achieve."


