1. Event organizer

This championship is SJF Ranking and one of the qualifying events to represent Singapore. Clubs/Coaches/Teachers are strongly encouraged to support the young promising athletes to participate the coming Youth (Cadet and Junior) Championship.

3. Eligibility

Participants must meet the following criteria: Minimum grade of 5th Kyu (Yellow Belt). Meet age requirements (Calendar Year).

Cadet:

a. **U18** - Boys and Girls must be 15 years old or above & under 18 years old. **Must be born between 2007 and 2009**.

Junior:

a. U21 - Men and Women must be 18 years old or above and under 21 years old. Must be born between 2004 and 2006.

For Athletes below 19 years old, parental consent is compulsory

Registered with SJF or National Judo Federation (proof required).

4. Competition regulations

The competition will be contested on 2 mat areas, in accordance with the 2024 International Judo Federation (IJF) Sports Rules and Regulations.

5. Judo Uniform

White uniform is compulsory (2024 IJF specifications).

6. System of contest

The matches will be contested in the 'League system' and/or the 'knock-out' system, depending on the number of entries received.

- If there is only one (1) participant registered for the category, the organizer shall cancel the category.
- If there are two (2) athletes it will be the best of two (2) contests and if the wins are equal (1-1), a third contest will decide.

7. Contest times

Match duration for the respective divisions shall be:

a. U18 - Cadet (Boys & Girls): 4 minutes b. U21 - Junior (Men & Women): 4 minutes

The International Judo Federation (IJF) scoring system will apply. In the event of a draw, the Golden Score rule will apply, and the match will continue until one winner is declared.

• U18 Category:

Both Shime-Waza (Chokes) and Kansetsu-Waza (Arm Locks) are not allowed.

• U21 Category:

Shime-Waza (Chokes) <u>is allowed</u> while Kansetsu-Waza (Arm Locks) <u>is not</u> allowed.

3. Eligibility

Team Composition

This team event is open to affiliated clubs of SJF. Each club may submit two teams for Male and two teams for Female Division only. A team must consist of a minimum of 3 (three) athletes. Each team will consist of up to 5 (five) athletes (for Men as well as for Women) and may have up to 5 (five) reserves.

Participants must meet the following criteria:

- a. Minimum grade of 4th Kyu (Orange belt) and above.
- **b.** All Team must register through their respective SJF affiliated school/club. *All registrations must be endorsed by a certified coach (local).
- **c.** Athletes below 19 years old must have parental consent.

4. Competition Regulations

The competition will be contested on 2 mat areas, in accordance with the 2024 International Judo Federation (IJF) Sports Rules and Regulations.

5. Judo Uniform

White and Blue judo uniforms are recommended.



6. Contest Times

7. System of Contest

The matches will be contested in the 'League system' and/or the 'knock-out' system, depending on the number of entries received. If there is only one Team for Men (1) and Women (1), registered for the event, the organizer shall cancel the event.

The International Judo Federation (IJF) scoring system will apply. In the event of a draw, the Golden Score rule will apply, and the match will continue until one winner is declared.

Team Contest

- a. During the contests the non-competing athletes must stay within a marked area on the contest area behind the coaches' chair. Reserve athletes must not enter the contest area
- b. Before each match the Team Manager or Captain must present to the event organizer the team line-up and they have the right to replace one or several athletes by other athletes of the corresponding weight category. If the team has no athlete in a category, they should select the "No Competitor" option.
- c. A minimum of three (3) athletes MUST be on the team line-up list.
- d. All competitors presented for the team match at the official bow on the mat must compete. If one competitor does not compete in their contest the team will lose by disqualification.
- e. If one team does not arrive for a match, the other team will be declared the winner by 5-0.
- f. The number of contests won will decide the winning team.
- g. If for any reason there is an equal number of wins and an equal number of score points, a draw will be made, and one couple will refight a golden score contest where the first score or penalty of any kind decides the winning team.



8. Divisions and Weight Categories

Each team shall comprise of **5 athletes** within the stipulated weight, from lightest to heaviest. **There will be no weight allowance.**
