PESTA SUKAN 2024 COMPETITION RULES & REGULATION – SWIMMING

Venue: OCBC Aquatic Centre Date: 26th to 28th July & 2nd August 2024

1. Rules

- 1.1 Guided by the Rules and Regulations as directed by the Singapore Swimming Association (SAQ) and in accordance with the Rules and By-laws of World Aquatics (AQUA) and World Para Swimming (WPS) Swimming Rules and Regulations, where applicable.
- 1.2 Governed by General Rules and Regulations.
- 1.3 Performance times achieved in the Competition can be used as Qualifying Entry Times for SAQ Long Course Competitions in 2025 e.g. SNAG 2025 & SNSC (LC) 2025.

2. Pesta Sukan 2024 Age Categories & Eligibility

 - 2.3.5 Swimming Schools run by swimming instructors
 - 2.3.6 Group of swimmers forming their own Swim Teams
- 2.3 Singapore Citizen, Permanent Residents and Foreigners residing in Singapore are eligible to participate.

3.2 Registration Procedure for Participants from SAQ Affiliates

- 3.4 Swimmers may "swim up" in older age group categories for relay events (for all youth + adult categories)
- 3.5 For Adult 18 Yrs to 29 Yrs relay categories, swimmer above 29 years old may "swim down" to compete in the adult category if the total age of relay team members do not add up to 120 years (minimum age of masters relays)
- 3.6 Swimmers who do not register for individuals but wish to swim only in the relay events may do so but will need to make a payment of \$20 for each team relay entry.

5. Competition Format

- 5.1 The Pesta Sukan Swimming will be run in a timed finals format in 10 Lanes Pool setup from fastest to slowest
- 5.2 Competitors (regardless of age) shall be placed in graduated time order, fastest to slowest in 10-lane pool based on the following age groups:

6. An Inclusive Pesta Sukan 2024

- 6.1.1 Pesta Sukan 2024 Swimming Competition will include Para Swimmers participation in:
 Pesta Sukan 2024 Events (50 and 100m for all 4 strokes)
- 6.1.2 Para Swimmers will follow WPS Sports Classes:
 - S1 S10 = Physical Impairments
 - S11 S13 = Visual Impairments
 - S14 = Intellectual Impairments
 - S15 = Hearing Impairments
 - S18 = Significant Other Impairment / Down Syndrome
 - S19 = High Functioning Autism
- 6.2 Para Swimmers will have their own ranking results and medals based on Multi-Class Point System. The Australian Point System will be used.
- 6.3 Para Swimmers will swim in their special Para Events

7. Entries & Fees

- 7.1 The closing date for making payment via registration portal is Friday 12th July 2024
- 7.2 Entry Fees for Individual Events:
 - Youth: \$15.00 per swimmer
 - Adults & Masters: \$20.00 per swimmer
 - Para Swimmers: \$10.00 per swimmer
 - Participants are allowed to take part up to Maximum of Five (5) Individual Events in his/her Age Category

7.3 Relay Entries:

- Each club / team / SAQ affiliate can submit more than 1 relay team in the respective relay categories (3.1.5) using Hy-tek Team Manager Software. Submission of Hytek Team Manager Entries to swim.entries@sgaquatics.org.sg
- Members of public (unattached swimmers who registered with individual events in Pesta Sukan Swimming) can form up their own relay teams and email in the details of the 4 relay swimmers to swim.entries@sgaquatics.org.sg.
- Non-SAQ Affiliates/Members of public must send in their relay entries to swim.entries@sgaquatics.org.sg by <u>Friday</u>, <u>5th July 2024</u>, <u>12.00pm</u>
- Individual swimmers who do not register for individual events but wish to swim only in the relay events may do so but will need to make a payment of \$20 for each team relay per event.
- There will be no additional Entry Fee for Relay Events if all relay team swimmers have an individual event each.

8 Viability of Events

- 8.1 Individual Events:
 - 8.1.1 For an event to be viable there must be a minimum of **4 Registered Swimmers**. However, if there are only 3 or 2 Registered Swimmers, the event will proceed with a minus one rule for the award of medals.

9. Awarding of Medals

- 9.1 If there is a tie in any of the top 3 positions, the medals will be awarded, in accordance with AQUA General Rule GR 9.7.2.1 and GR 9.7.2.2 as follows:
 - 9.1.1 In the case of two (2) equal times:

For 1st position: 2 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
 For 2nd position: 1 Gold, 2 Silvers, no Bronze
 For 3rd position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 2 Bronzes

- 9.1.2 In the case of three (3) equal times:
 - For 1st position: 3 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
 For 2nd position: 1 Gold, 3 Silvers, no Bronze
 For 3rd position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 3 Bronzes
- 9.2 **Prize Money** will be awarded after the entire competition concludes and will be awarded only to the best individual performer of each of the following individual age categories from each gender:

- 9.2.1 GetActive Pesta Sukan will award the Best Individual Performer to the best swimmer in each respective age group with the total number of points from a maximum of 5 Individual Events.
- 9.2.2 In the case of a tie, World Aquatics Points will be used to decide the overall winner based on the total points accumulated.
- 9.2.3

9.2.4 GetActive Pesta Sukan will award the Best Individual Performer to the best para swimmer 18 years and over, with the total number of points (deriving from the Australian Multi Class Point System) from a maximum of 5 Individual Events.


The Multi Class Point Score (MCPS) provides a simplified way for swimmers and coaches to measure and compare performances for swimmers with an eligible classification.

10. DNS and Withdrawals for Pesta Sukan Swimming 2024

10.1 During competition, any swimmer who fails to report for the event will be considered as Did Not Show (DNS). A swimmer, having entered the venue, is also considered as DNS if he/she fails to be at the Starting Block.

11. Swimwear

- 11.1 The Championship will be conducted in accordance to AQUA's Rules:
 - BL 8.2: In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces. No additional items, like arm bands or leg bands shall be regarded as part of a swimsuit.
 - BL 8.3: From January 1, 2010 swimwear for men shall not extend above the navel nor below the knee, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials.



12. Disqualification

12.1 The Competition will use the One Start Rule. Any swimmer who starts before the starting signal shall be disqualified. If the race has started before the disqualification is declared, the race shall continue, and the swimmer(s) shall be disqualified upon completion of the race.

13. Protest

- 13.1 Protests are possible:
- a. if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed,
- b. if other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or
- against decisions of the referee; however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.
- 13.2 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee.
- 13.3 If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged before the signal to start the race is given.
- 13.4 Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:
- a. In writing, with the supporting facts
- b. With a deposit of \$\$100.00 enclosed
- c. Submitted to the Meet Referee by Affiliate Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained
- d. Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the respective event
- 13.5 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his decision. The Team Leader may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.
- 13.6 If the protest is not upheld, the deposit shall be forfeited
- 13.7 The Organiser's decision to any protest shall be final.

14 Rules & Regulations

- 14.1 The Rules and Regulations as depicted above are current at the time of printing or posting on Pesta Sukan 2024 website. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete and/or vary the said rules and regulations at any time as it deems fit.
- 14.2 Any amendments to the Rules & Regulations will be posted on Pesta Sukan 2024 website.

15. Team Leaders Meeting / Briefing

- 15.1 Team Leaders Meeting / Briefing will be conducted online via Zoom on 23rd July, 2024 11.00am. Zoom meeting link will be provided on a later date.
- Swim Coaches who wish to apply for an accreditation pass to be on deck during Pesta Sukan must be an NROC Member.
 Clubs / Schools are required to send in the names of their coaches and team managers (min age of 18 years old based on DOB) with their entry files to secure a pass.

16. Others (for Members of SAQ Affiliates)

For participants who registered for the Pesta Sukan Competition as the members of SAQ Affiliates, the performance times achieved at the Pesta Sukan can be used for consideration to qualify for future local / national meets and will be uploaded onto the SAQ sanctioned database for ranking purposes. These participants must also pay the 2024 SAQ Annual Swimmer Registration Fee via the SAQ Affiliate by 31st August 2024

Participants who competed at Pesta Sukan as unattached (or not as a member of any SAQ affiliates) will not have their results uploaded onto the SAQ sanctioned database.
