INTEGRATED MOVEMENT SINGAPORE APPROACH

This approach integrates movement with all aspects of a preschooler's life by incorporating strategies such as **Active Navigation Routes**, **Active Play Corners, Brain Breaks** and **Integrated Learning**.

ACTIVE NAVIGATION ROUTE

Active Navigation Route is a movement course within the preschool that encourages preschoolers to use a variety of movements to get from point to point. Below is an example of an active navigation route.

HIGH FREQUENCY WORDS STEPPING STONE

To get preschoolers to do the following:

OBJECTIVE:

- Move along the corridor while applying learnt motor skills (i.e.hopping, jumping, sliding)
- Practise literacy skills (i.e. High frequency words)
- Increase body movement activities

HOW TO PLAY:

- 1. Preschooler will read and say out each word written on the 'stone'.
- 2. He/she will jump on each 'stone' according to the route.

Print the stickers with the targeted words and plan the route before pasting them.

EC educators should bear in mind the following:

- The size of the words on the stones and the stones should be big enough to be seen.
- The distance between each stones should be within jumping distance for the preschoolers.
