INTEGRATED MOVEMENT APPROACH



This approach integrates movement with all aspects of a preschooler's life by incorporating strategies such as **Active Navigation Routes**, **Active Play Corners**, **Brain Breaks** and **Integrated Learning**.

BRAIN BREAKS

Brain Breaks are short bursts of movement activities that EC educators can introduce in between lessons to help preschoolers refocus their attention. Below is an example of a brain break.



OBJECTIVE: To get preschoolers active and moving.

HOW TO

- 1. The EC educator will say "Blow, wind, blow".
- 2. The preschoolers will ask "Blow, what?"
- 3. The EC educator will reply "Blow all those wearing glasses."
- 4. The preschoolers who are wearing glasses will need to exchange seats.
- 5. The EC educator will then repeat for other characteristics of the preschoolers.
