This approach integrates movement with all aspects of a preschooler's life by incorporating strategies such as Active Navigation Routes, Active Play Corners, Brain Breaks and Integrated Learning.

## INTEGRATED LEARNING

Integrated lesson plans, as a movement strategy, incorporate literacy or numeracy skills into the preschoolers' gross motor experiences. Below is an example of an integrated lesson plan.

## MOVE AND COUNT



1. Learn to count in multiples of 2 up to 20 .

OBJECTIVE: 2. Balance walks on a beam.
3. Jump continuously.

1. Preschoolers will find a partner and queue in pairs.

HOW TO PLAY:
2. They will complete the obstacle course such as balance walk on a beam and jump over obstacles to reach the other side.
3. They will then count in multiples of 2 as each pair reaches the other end.
